Warm greetings from Korea University in Seoul, Korea.

Korea University, founded in 1905, is widely acknowledged as one of the country's oldest, largest and top-ranked universities. The university's academic breadth is extensive with 81 departments in 22 colleges and schools, 22 graduate programs, 137 research institutes, 33 auxiliary facilities, and medical facilities which include a teaching hospital. It has more than 1,696 full-time faculty members and 27,739 undergraduate and 9,579 graduate students.

KU was ranked 90th by QS World University Rankings in 2017. It has been recognized as one of the top 100 universities worldwide in art and humanities and social science and management. KU is now considered a world class research-oriented university. KU stands among the top 100 universities in 24 out of 46 subject areas evaluated.

Korea University placed eight out of a total of 46 specific subjects in the top 50, resulting in the best performance among the private universities in Korea. Compared to the last year's survey, Korea University added six more subjects to its entries by subject. It is notable that the university ranked in the top 50 in the Law subject ranking which was assessed for the first time by the rating agency.

The colleges of Engineering and of Life Sciences and Biotechnology at KU are continuously expanding academic exchanges with notable Chinese universities as part of projects 211 and 985(Chinese government funded programs). KU Business School is the first in Korea to be accredited by both *AACSB* and *EQUIS*, two prominent business school accreditation organizations.

Korea University offers advanced master's and doctoral degrees spanning the humanities, social sciences, natural sciences and engineering. These programs share a number of distinctive and desirable features: a high level of engagement between distinguished faculty members, outstanding students and a rich campus environment. Complementing and enriching these degree-granting programs are a wide range of interdisciplinary units that promote intellectual activities and research across departmental and divisional boundaries.

KU is constantly seeking to create an environment for advanced cutting-edge research and state-of-the-art education to become a global leader and academic pioneer. We aim to attract outstanding students from diverse cultural and ethnic backgrounds with the qualities of character and potential to help build an intellecturally stimulating environment for student learning.
